STATE OF THE UNIVERSITY (BSU)

This event aims to ensure that Boise State is developing their students to supply Boise employers with the type of talent they need to grow their businesses and fuel our local economy. In addition, attendees will hear exciting news and updates from BSU about their growth and expansion into the downtown Boise area.

SMALL BUSINESS & CHAMBER EXCELLENCE AWARDS

We have a long-standing tradition of recognizing our members' excellence. Each year, we honor Chamber member companies with awards at our annual Small Business of the Year and Chamber Excellence Awards luncheon. The luncheon also celebrates one outstanding business and community leader whom we induct into the Boise Metro Chamber Hall of Fame.





HOLIDAY RECEPTION WITH ELECTED OFFICIALS

Join us for our annual Holiday Reception with Elected Officials. Meet and greet state officers, area legislators, mayors, county commissioners, community college trustees, city council members, school board members, highway commissioners, and auditorium district directors.

GOLF CLASSIC
