Staff or Resident Engineer *Position open until filled.*

We are looking for an experienced Professional Engineer that is able to immediately fulfill either Staff Engineer or Resident Engineer level responsibilities. The selected candidate's level of experience will determine the nature of this position. A qualified Resident Engineer should have extensive experience in the below-listed work items, preferably following Idaho Transportation Department processes. A Staff Engineer should have roadway and bridge construction experience with an ability to work toward the administration of projects largely independently.

Experience for this position may include:

- Preparing Requests for Information (RFIs) or Requests for Proposals (RFPs) to solicit CE&I services
- Assisting or acting as a Resident Engineer in selecting and managing project Construction Engineering & Inspection (CE&I) consultants
- Overseeing all aspects of roadway and bridge construction projects including work with Local Agencies, Contractors, Consultants, and the Public
- Assisting or acting as the Resident Engineer in preparation and review of RFI's, Requests for Change (RFC), Change Orders, Contractor Estimates, Construction Claims, and Contractor Submittals
- Field Construction Inspection
- Participation in constructability review meetings with local agencies, consultants, and other staff at different phases of Design

Qualifications:

- Bachelors' degree in civil engineering required from an ABET-accredited institution
- Idaho driver's license
- Licensed as a Professional Engineer by the State of Idaho in good standing required
- Experience in construction management or roadway and bridge construction engineering is preferred; familiarity with the Idaho Transportation Department (ITD) and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is a plus
- Highly skilled candidates with at least 8 years of applicable experience may qualify to be hired as a Resident Engineer
- An equivalent combination of education and experience that provides the required skills, knowledge, and abilities to successfully perform the essential functions of the position may be considered

Salary:

Commensurate with experience and responsibilities but the normal hiring range would be \$83,000-\$94,000
